Going against conventional wisdom, this presentation examines how deficits and challenges so pervasively attributed to autism and other disabilities can be reframed as strengths. Employing an autobiographical structure combined with experiences of others with autism and other disabilities, participants will come away with practical solutions for considering characteristics of people with learning difference as potential springboards to success in

education from preschool to post graduate, employment, effective self-advocacy, meaningful engagement in the community as building blocks for leading a fulfilling and productive life.

Attendees will be able to:

1. List at least three situations where deficits can become strengths.
2. Develop a familiarity as to how strengths can be used to navigate around challenges.
3. Learn that considered decisions can be made to avoid areas of challenge while still leading a fulfilling and productive life.
4. Understand the importance of people with autism and other disabilities in understanding themselves as a key factor in success.
